

## Selection Index 95 ESG

### Description

The "Selection Index 95 ESG" strategy invests in pure index funds and is implemented so as to ensure that the return and risk on the portfolio match the benchmark as closely as possible. The strategy is reviewed each year based on clearly defined selection criteria, and adjusted as necessary. You benefit from low product costs and the portfolio can be delivered to your private assets upon withdrawal. The strategic equity content is 95%.

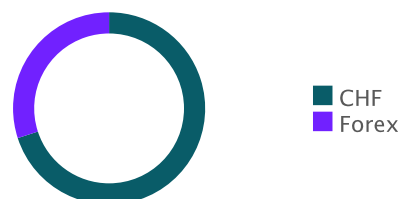

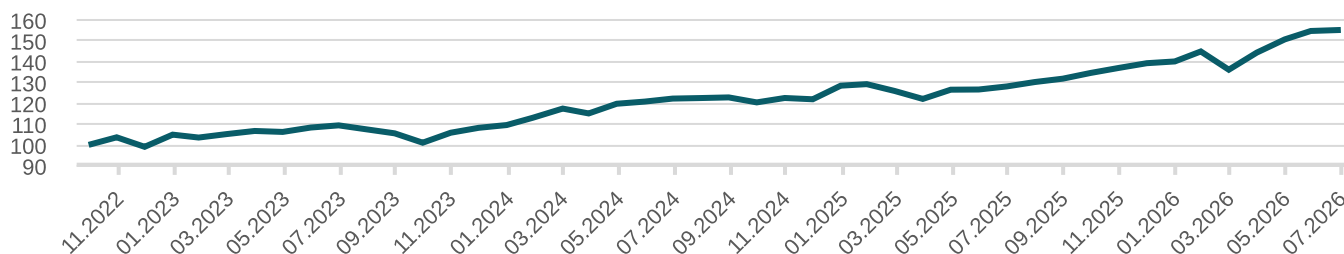

### Methodology

The funds used are committed to the "ESG approach", although there is no uniform approach to implementation. ESG stands for the aspects environment (E), social (S) and corporate governance (G). ESG funds normally reduce or avoid risks associated with sectors such as weapons, tobacco, fossil fuels, gambling or adult entertainment. Engagement with companies is also often sought ("stewardship voting" / "engagement").
